

“360 Walk-Around”
“Don’t be Risky – Do a 360”

Purpose: To eliminate incidents and injuries related to accidental contact with equipment and vehicles.

Concept: Reinforces with all equipment operators and drivers of vehicles the need to physically conduct a 360-degree walk around. In doing so, they can visually observe all areas surrounding the equipment/vehicle for any hazards that may affect its safe operation. This action, when conducted before entering the equipment/vehicle, reduces the possibility of injury or damage.

Reasoning: Construction sites are an ever-changing work environment. By raising awareness with equipment, operators and drivers of vehicles this program helps reduce incidents related to equipment operations.

Requirements:

Note: A specific 360 reminder may be better suited for different types of vehicles/equipment.

- 1) This program is required to be adhered to by operators on all self-propelled/mobile equipment and drivers of vehicles on Cajun jobsites.
- 2) Operators/drivers are required to walk in a complete circle around their self-propelled/mobile equipment or vehicle to ensure, the areas beneath the equipment and around the equipment are clear and free of hazards.
